Madhya Pradesh again performed poorly in National Institution Ranking Framework (NIRF) - 2022 rankings with even institutions like HT Indore and HM Indore slipping from their last year's positions. No university from the state found place in top-100 varsities in the country.

IISER Bhopal, MANIT Bhopal, National Law University Bhopal and IIITDM Jabalpur, you name the institute and all have slipped from their last year's position.

The only saving grace was that Devi Ahilya Vishwavidyalaya managed to retain its place in the band of 101-150 universities.

IIT Indore, which was ranked 13th in engineering category last year, slipped three notches down to 16th position this year whereas IIM Indore, which was ranked 6th in management category last year, went one position down to 7th position this year.
