

NIRF REPORT CARD: WAKE-UP CALL FOR MADHYA PRADESH

Edu rankings: IIT-M tops for 4th year, IIT-D at 4

New Delhi: Indian Institute of Technology, Madras (IIT-M) and Delhi's top institutions including Miranda House, IIT, Jawaharlal Nehru University, AIIMS and Jamia Millia Islamia continued their good show in the National Institutional Ranking Framework for 2022.

For the fourth year running, IIT-M was adjudged India's top educational institution (overall) and continued to be ranked the "best engineering institution", a position it has consecutively bagged since the rankings were introduced in 2016.

Miranda House too retained its pole position in the college category, which it has maintained since the category's introduction in

2017. Indian Institute of Science, Bengaluru, topped in the university and research categories.

Sought-after colleges such as St Stephen's, Shri Ram College of Commerce (SRCC) and Lady Shri Ram (LSR) have dropped in the rankings, with St Stephen's not in the top 10 for the first time.

MP's top institutes slip in national ratings

Indore/Bhopal: Madhya Pradesh's premier educational institutions slipped in the National Institute Ranking Framework (NIRF) rankings 2022 announced on Friday.

IIM-Indore ranked seventh in the management category, down a notch from last year, while IIT-Indore, which had secured 30th rank overall in 2021, fell one place to 31st this year. It lost its position in the engineering category, too, falling from 13th in 2021 to 16th in 2022. In the research category introduced last year, IIT-Indore maintained its 26th rank.

Universities and colleges of Bhopal fared no better. Not a single university or college could make the top-100 cut.

Only IISER managed a

place in the overall top 100 institutes in the country, ranking 61 but down 11 ranks compared to 2021, with an overall score of 49.29 points. In the research institutions category, IISER came 49th with 39.51 points.

IIM-I secures 7th spot in NIRF rankings

Indore: Indian Institute of Management, Indore (IIM-Indore) on Thursday secured the seventh position in the management category of National Institute Ranking Framework (NIRF) rankings 2022, slipping a notch from last year's sixth rank.

This year, the ranking has been declared for eleven categories -- overall, university,

management, college, pharmacy, medical, engineering, architecture, dental, law and research Institutions.

Indian Institute of Technology, Indore (IIT-I), which had secured 30th rank in overall 2021 NIRF rankings, fell one point to secure 31st overall rank this year. It lost its positions in the engineering category, falling from 13th in 2021

to 16th in 2022.

In the research category introduced last year, IIT Indore maintained the 26th rank.

The NIRF India Ranking parameters and the weighted averages adopted to derive the rankings differ for all the categories. The broad categories adopted to rank the colleges, universities

and institutes include teaching, learning and resources; research and professional practice; graduation outcomes; outreach and inclusivity and peer perception.

Indore's Government Dental College secured 39th rank. Last year, it had secured 32nd rank.

Shri Govindram Seksaria Institute of technology and Science (SGSITS) is the only state government autonomous engineering institute of Madhya Pradesh which appeared in the top 200 list of NIRF ranking list of 2021. TNN
