Indian Institute of Technology Indore signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Ministry of Education & Ministry of Innovation and Technology, Ethiopia to promote bilateral cooperation with Ethiopian Universities.

Under this pact, 46 Ethiopian Universities will become Partner Institute to promote various academic and research programmes.

The MoU was signed by IIT Indore director Prof Suhas S Joshi and Dr Bayissa Badada Badassa, State Minister, Ministry of Innovation and Technology, Ethiopia for a joint multidisciplinary international quality improvement PhD programme, which will pave the way for student and faculty exchange.
