A total of around 529 students have so far been coached in four boot camps conducted at Medi-Caps University, Indore, IPS Academy, Indore, Government Madhav Science College, Ujjain and -Rewa Engineering College.

The technical sessions of the boot camps covered various aspects of startup and entrepreneurship such as picking a startup idea, developing the idea into a minimum viable product, creating a successful startup, key terms and jargons in startup, basics of valuation, funding avenues and basics of IP for entrepreneurs among others.
