IT-I UP AT 14TH, IIM-I SLIPS TO 8TH; NO STATE VARSITY IN TOP-100 LIST

AIIMS BHOPAL 38th in medical category, NILU SLIPS three positions, DAVV RETAINS ranking

Indian Institute of Technology-Indore (IIT-I) climbed while Indian Institute of Management-Indore (IIM-I) slipped down from last year's position in Indian Higher Education Rankings-2023 released by National Institute Ranking Framework on Monday.

On the other hand, Devi Ahilya Vishwavidyalaya (DAVV) managed to retain its place in the band of 101-150 universities whereas Indore Government Dental College improved its rank from last year's 39 to 32.Apart from these, most of the other institutes in MP have slipped in ranking this year.

AIIMS Bhopal also entered the rankings this year securing 38th

position in medical category, Maulana Azad National Institute of Technology (MANIT) and National Institute Law University in Bhopal slipped from their position.

Like past many years, this year also no university of Madhya Pradesh managed to secure place in top-100 universities in the country.

IIT-Indore, which had secured 16th rank in the engineering category last year, climbed two notches to secure 14th position this year.

IIT-Indore improved its rankings in overall category and research category from last year's 31st to 28th and 26th to 21st position this year respectively.

IIM Indore, which was ranked 7th in the management category last year, slipped one position to 8th position this year.

IIT-M best institution, IISc best varsity

NIRF 2023: IIT Madras best institution for 5th consecutive year, IISc retains best varsity spot for 8th year in a row New Delhi, Jun 5 (PTI) Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Madras retained the top spot among institutes in the country for the fifth consecutive year, while Bengalurubased Indian Institute of Science was adjudged the best university and research institution, according to the education ministry's National Institutional Ranking Framework.

The rankings were announced by Union Minister of State for Education Rajkumar Ranjan Singh on Monday. The eighth edition of the NIRF observed that faculty with doctoral qualifications are mostly concentrated in the top 100 institutions. This is a serious handicap since mentorship received during the doctoral training can play a vital role in preparing the faculty for a teaching career in higher education, it noted.
