'Forty families lost a son, a husband, a brother'



Amit Trivedi paid tribute to the Pulwama martyrs at the IIT fest in Indore on Sunday

An emotional Amit Trivedi paid tribute to the 40 CRPF jawans who lost their lives in the Pulwama attack at IIT Indore's fest Fluxus '19. The Bollywood composer, singer and lyricist sang his track *Namo Namah Shankara*, "as a tribute and a prayer to the jawans and their families".

"The attack that happened in J&K on the 14th is one of the

most terrible things to have happened in our country. I cannot even begin to imagine the plight of the martyred soldiers' families. *Humare yahan koi beemar bhi padh jaata hai toh sab tension mein aa jaate hain*. These families lost a precious member of their household – 40 families lost a son, a husband, a brother," said Amit on stage, before he began singing. He broke down in tears towards the end of the number.
