

IIT-I rises to 12th rank in engg, IIM-I retains 8th in mgmt

Indore: Indian Institute of Technology, Indore climbed to the 12th position in the engineering category of the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) 2025, released by the Ministry of Education on Thursday. The institute also secured the 24th rank

in research and the 27th rank in the overall category, improving from 16th, 27th, and 33rd places respectively in 2024.

The institute scored 66.65 in engineering, showcasing steady growth in academic and research standards. "Climbing to the 12th position in the NIRF 2025 Engineering category is a proud moment for all of

us at IIT Indore. This recognition reflects the relentless efforts of our faculty, students, staff, and alumni in driving excellence in teaching, research, and innovation. We will continue to nurture talent, foster innovation, and strengthen our contributions towards building a self-reliant and globally competitive India," said

IIM Indore continued its consistent run among the top management institutions. With a score of 75.68, it retained the 8th position for the second consecutive year. The institute was placed 7th in 2022 and 2023.

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The institute was placed 7th in 2022 and 2023, demonstrating its sustained strength in management education.

DAVV also improved its standing. While it did not feature in the 100–150 band of the overall university category this year, it ranked 49th among state public universities with a score of 50.41, up from the 50th position last year with 48.35. DAVV is the

only state public university to be ranked in the top 50 universities from Madhya Pradesh.

NIRF 2025 covered 17 categories including overall, universities, colleges, engineering, research, management, medical, law, pharmacy, agriculture, and sustainable development goals. The performance of Indore's institutions across different categories once again underscored the city's reputation as an emerging hub of higher education in India. TNN
