

IIT-I to launch 3 new UG progs

Indore: Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Indore will introduce three new undergraduate programmes from 2026-27 session, expanding its academic portfolio in areas linked to sustainability, healthcare and advanced chemical sciences.

The new courses include a Bachelor of Science in Applied & Industrial Chemistry, BTech in Environmental Economics and Sus-

tainable Engineering, and BTech in Biomedical Engineering and Data Science.

The four-year Applied and Industrial Chemistry course will be offered by department of chemistry and admit 20 students. It will focus on core chemical sciences, engineering and computational elements.

BTech in Environmental Economics and Sustainable Engineering will have an intake of 30 students. It combines engineering fundamen-

tals with environmental science and sustainability-focused economics.

The Biomedical Engineering and Data Science course will also admit 30 students.

"These programmes reflect our commitment to developing future leaders who can innovate across disciplines and contribute meaningfully to national and global sustainable development goals," IIT-I director Prof Suhass Joshi said.
