EXPERTS DISCUSS TECH-DRIVEN SOLUTIONS IN AGRICULTURE AT IIT-I



Indian Institute of Technology, Indore organised a workshop, 'Future of Agriculture – Deep Agri Technology, Markets and FPOs' in collaboration with BharatKhand and Solidaridad. The event brought together farmer producer organisations, agri-industries, and researchers to discuss scaling technology-driven solutions. Director Suhas S Joshi stressed the role of academic institutions in driving social impact through innovation. Experts highlighted advances in seed technology, disease forecasting, and gene editing. Sessions focused on AI-based crop advisory, groundwater management and soil analysis tools. Panel discussions addressed market linkages and supply chain gaps, while six stalls showcased agricultural innovations. The workshop outlined plans for field trials, farmer surveys and feedback systems to strengthen adoption of deep agritech solutions.
