## IIT-I maintains its top 400 global ranking

## **ELITE** institute again pips older IITs to post

Indian Institute of Technology, Indore, maintained its top 400 global ranking for the second consecutive year in World University Rankings-2020 announced at Times Higher Education summit in Zurich on Wednesday. The institute continues on upward trajectory and in the process has carved a niche for itself among the various reputed international institutions.

IIT Indore has been ranked in 351-400 band, out of 1,396 ranked institutions from 92 countries worldwide (1,258 institutions in 2018). Overall, 1,820 institutions participated in this exercise in 2019. Like previous year, this year too IIT Indore raced ahead of all older IITs, ranked 400 and below (see table).

IIT Indore continues to be top ranking IIT among second generation (2G) IITs in terms of H-index and citations. H-index (Hirsch index) and Citations encapsulates the productivity and

Higher H-index and citation reflects importance and global outreach of an institution's research work. Teaching: 30%; Research: 30%; Citations: 30%; Industry income: 2.5% and International outlook: 7.5%/ IIT Indore has been judged across all above mentioned performance indicators, with overall score range of 42.4-44.4. The institute has scored 32.5 in Teaching, 23.7 in Research, 39.9 in Industry income and 19.7 in International outreach. Citations with a value of 77.1 is the highest ranked pillar for IIT Indore. When contacted, Director of IIT Indore, Prof. Pradeep Mathur said, "This is as per our vision. IIT Indore continues to be one of the fastest-growing institutes globally. In not too long a future, we are confident of breaking into Top 200 in the Times Higher Education World Rankings".
