

## AWC hosts IIT Youth group

Yuva Sangam, operationalised by the Ministry of Education, seeks to foster mutual understanding and unity among the youth of different states by pairing institutions and regions under the "Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat" framework. In this pairing, Madhya Pradesh (with IIT Indore as the nodal institution) is connected with Jharkhand.
