

50 Youth Delegates Leave For Jharkhand Under Yuva Sangam



IIT Indore flagged off a 50-member Madhya Pradesh youth delegation to IIT (ISM) Dhanbad in Jharkhand under Yuva Sangam Phase VI, an initiative of the Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat programme. Selected from over 3,200 applicants through a multi-stage process, the contingent includes 23 male and 27 female

participants from more than 40 districts of the state.
