pated in the national 'BRSI Biotechnology Popularisation and Skill Development Program' at IIT Indore under the 'Science Circle' activities of the PM SHRI scheme.

Before the programme, the

students were motivated by the school principal to make the most of the opportunity.

During the programme, the students attended expert sessions aligned with the national BioE3 Policy. They also

took part in a science quiz and won multiple prizes.

The highlight of the visit was a technical tour of the Sophisticated Instrumentation Centre (SIC). Guided by experts, including Bhavsar,

the students gained first-hand exposure to advanced research equipment and their applications. They learned the working principles of Nuclear Magnetic Resonance (NMR) Spectrometry, Mass

Spectrometry, Scanning Electron Microscopy (SEM), X-Ray Diffraction (XRD), Single Crystal XRD, Thermogravimetric Analysis (TGA), and automated elemental and surface area analysers.
