research work and making Indore a hub for value added teaching and learning. As per the memorandum, IIT Indore will extend its support to DAVV by providing access to its world class laboratories and research facilities. Both institutions will work towards interaction and collaborations between faculty and students for value-added study, teaching, learning and advance research. The MoU also has provision to add upon other areas of co-operation mutually agreed upon by institutes.
