

IIT-I extends mid-term break till Mar 29

INDORE: Indian Institute of Technology Indore has extended mid-term break of students till March 29 in view of coronavirus outbreak. "The classes were to resume after mid-term break on Monday but the institute extended the break till March 29," said IIT Indore public relation officer Sunil Kumar. IIT Indore on Tuesday had suspended all the classes and exams with immediate effect. All the students were also advised to vacate their hostel rooms and return to their homes.
