

IIT Indore central school starts with 200 students

Admissions have been granted to the maiden batch of Kendriya Vidyalaya recently established at the Indian Institute of Technology Indore campus, in Simrol. The school has started with class 1 to 5.

As many as 40 students have been granted admission in each of the classes, totalling 200 students in the first academic session. Most of the children given admission are outsiders; very few

IIT Indore staff members have sent their children to the central school. The institute has signalled at taking students up to standard 8 from the next academic session.
