## 15 scientists connected to MP institutions in world's top 2% scientists list

As many as 15 scientists, who were or are associated with higher education institutions in the state, have featured among the top two per cent scientists in a global list compiled by the prestigious **US-based** Stanford University.

The university lately released the list which carries names of the most-cited scientists in various disciplines. Nearly 1500 scientists, engineers and doctors are from India in the list having names of as many as 1,59,683 persons.
