

IIT-Indore to get full fledged director soon

Indian Institute Technology (IIT) Indore is going to get a full fledged director soon. Government of India, Ministry of Education, Technical Department - 1 has invited applications from interested candidates for the directorship at the elite technical institute in Indore, which was established in 2009.

Pradeep Mathur was appointed as the first director of the institute. His

first term ended in 2014. Mathur got an extension of another five years and completed another term in December 2019.

Following this, Neelesh Kumar Jain was appointed as officiating director thereafter.

Appointment was necessitated after Mathur's second term, but Jain was made officiating sending a signal that appointment of full-fledged director is still afar. Almost a year later, the appointment of a new director is in process now.
