KV IIT gets sanction up to Class 9

Indore: Kendriya Vidyalaya (KV) on IIT-Indore campus has received sanction up to Class IX for academic session 2021-22 starting June 21st.

Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan issued a revised order in May sanctioning classes upto IX with one section in each class for the academic session 2021-22 at KV IIT-I.

The is country's 1,242 nd Kendriya Vidyalaya for which IIT, Indore has given its 'Schoolbuilding' to run the campus.

Professor Neelesh Kumar Jain, officiating director, IIT-I said, "KV IIT Indore campus has got sanction up to class IX from the new academic session 2021-22. The set up will benefit the IIT-I community and nearby villages as KV has a value-based education system and structured syllabus that offers bilingual instruction in English and Hindi."

The approval for setting up the central school in IIT-I was issued in June 2020 with initial permission to start with classes 1 to 5th in the academic session 2020-21, which was later altered to include class 6th in an order issued in March this year.

The central school at present has around 219 students in classes II to VI, while admission for class I is under process.

Acting on the revised order from Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan, new admissions for classes VII to IX that have 40 seats in each class, is also underway and schools will reopen from June 21, 2021. TNN
