

IIT Indore slips from 55th to 78th rank

Indian Institute of Technology Indore, which was ranked 55th in The Times Higher Education Asia University Rankings-2020, slipped to 23 notches down to 78th position in this year's rankings.

However, it was 3rd amongst Indian Universities after Indian Institute of Science Bangalore (Rank#37) and Indian Institute of Technology Ropar (Rank#55).

Both the institutes have also climbed down from their last year's ranks. Last year, IISc Bangalore was ranked 36th and Indian Institute of Technology Ropar had received 47th rank.

The universities were judged on the basis of their



performance indicators like number of FTE students, number of students per staff, international students, female to male ratio etc.

Last year, a total number of four universities had made it to top-100 universities but that figure was down to three this year.

But the number of Indian universities making to the top-200 list rose from 15 last year to 18 this year.
