IIT-I yet to decide venue for convocation

Indore: The Indian Institute of Technology, Indore (HT-I), is in a fix to finalize venue for its first convocation ceremony. President Pranab Mukherjee has already given consent to attend the convocation ceremony to be held on June 8.

The premier engineering institute has not shifted to its own campus after four long years. As such, the institute authorities have three options for the venue: Simrol where the institute had to come up, PACL campus where part of institute operates and the third is DAVV auditorium.

"The institute is looking for the venue that is safe as per the security reasons. Nearly, six weeks are left for the ceremony. Date and chief guest are finalized. The institute needs to finalize the venue as it has to be forwarded to the President's office," said a source. Meanwhile, the institute has ordered convocation gowns for the batch strength of over hundred stu-

dents in the undergraduate courses, sources said.
