

# IIT-I starts admission for M Tech

## Selects 12 Students For The Course

**Indore:** At a time when the first batch of B Tech pass outs from Indian Institute of Technology, Indore (IIT-I) are about to take up jobs in the corporate sector, the institute has announced start of its first M Tech (post graduate) course from this academic year.

The institute has offered admission for its first M Tech programme in production and industrial engineering in the mechanical engineering discipline for academic year 2013-14. The institute has selected 12 students for the PG course. The students will be given teaching assistantship during the course of study.

The institute has offered admission to all the students and has sought their confirmation of acceptance latest by May 27. The registration of the students will take place on July 22 at the PACL campus of the institute and classes will commence from July 23.

The institute is expected to start few more M Sc and M Tech courses this year.



### DOCTORAL PROGRAMMES

As part from M Tech courses, the institute has also announced special provision for military service personnel for pursuing PhD program at the institute. Depending on the experience of the candidate, the coursework requirements would be decided on a case to case basis. Maximum time period for submitting PhD thesis shall be eight years.
