

IIT-Indore director's tenure ends

Indore: Tenure of incumbent Indian Institute of Technology, Indore (IIT-I), expired in 2014.

However, appointed in 2010, Prof Pradeep Mathur will continue to serve as institute director till the final decision on new director gets approval from Ministry of Human Resources and Development (MHRD).

NEW APPOINTMENT

Confirming the development, media coordinator of the institute Nirmala Menon said, "Director's tenure has expired. But he will continue to remain in seat till the decision on new director is taken by the MHRD. The decision might take another two to three months".

In general, prior to expiry of director's tenure applications are invited from suitable candidates.

A search panel is constituted to scrutinise applications for shortlisting candidates.

Shortlisted candidates are called to appear for an interview. Final decision on the selection is taken by MHRD.
