Indore to run for saving environment tomorrow

As part of their pre-techno-cultural festival — Fluxus, students of Indian Institute of Technology, Indore have organised a marathon in the city on Sunday. The theme of the marathon is 'Save the Environment'. The marathon is open to all.

In a press release, Gaurav Karmarkar of IIT-Indore said, "Fluxus-2016 officially kick starts its campaign with a city-wide marathon on Sunday at Dussehra Maidan with a message of 'Save the Environment' in order to create general awareness for environment protection. The marathon will start at 7:30 am sharp

and will cover an approximate distance of 6 kilometres on the track of Dussehra Maidan, Ranjit Hanuman Circle, Footi Kothi Chauraha, Gopur Circle, Chanakyapuri and return to the starting point. All the participants have been suggested to report at the venue by 6:30 am for on-the-spot registration.

Prizes worth Rs 55,000 will be awarded to the winners and certificates will be given to all the participants by the students of IIT-Indore.

IIT-Indore is all set to host the 6th edition of central India's largest techno-cultural college festival, Fluxus-2016. The 3-day and 4-nights celebration from February 4 to 7 is set to transcend all the thresholds of science

and entertainment. This being the first look of IIT, Indore's Simrol Campus for outsiders, the city is already buzzing with excitement.

Indore marathon on February 7

Indore marathon would be organised by a local organisation on February 7. The theme of this marathon is 'Cleaner, Greener and Healthy Indore'. The runs conducted as part of Indore marathon are: first 21.09 km, second 10 km and third 5 km. The winner of 21.09 km run would be awarded a cash prize of Rs 100000, while runner-up will get Rs 50000, each in men and women's categories.
