

# IIM-I is 10th best, IIT-I gets 16th slot

## SGSITS from city also figures in the list of best pharmacy institutes

Apart from IIM-Indore, Indian Institute of Forest Management in Bhopal and Indian Institute of Information Technology & Management in Gwalior from the state find place in the list of top 25 b-schools in the country; ITM University (Gwalior) secures 32nd position

Dr Harisingh Gour Vishwavidyalaya (Sagar) and Jaypee University of Engineering and Technology (Raghogarh) from the state ranked 39th and 86th best universities, respectively

Apart from IIT-Indore, School of Engineering & Technology of ITM University (Gwalior) and Pandit Dwarka Prasad Mishra Indian Institute of Information Technology, Design and Manufacturing, Jabalpur secure 58th and 77th positions, respectively, in the list of best engineering institutes

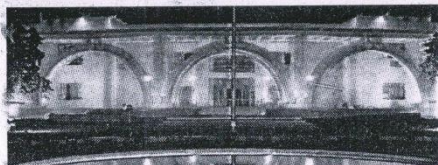
SGSITS (Indore) and BR Nahata College of Pharmacy (Mandsaur) secure 40th and 44th positions, respectively, in the list of top 50 pharmacy institutes

Indian Institute of Management, Indore is the 10th best b-school and Indian Institute of Technology, Indore is the 16th best engineering institute in the country, according to the "Indian Rankings 2016" announced on Monday.

Besides, nine more institutions from the state have found place in the top 100 universities and institutes in Engineering, Management and Pharmacy in the country.

Indian Institute of Forest Management (Bhopal) and Indian Institute of Information Technology & Man-



agement (Gwalior) from the state have been ranked as 8th and 22nd best management institutes in the country.

IIFM, Bhopal is two notches above IIM-Indore in the list of best management institutes in the country.

While IIFM, Bhopal scored 81.01 marks out of 100, IIM-Indore clinched 78.63 marks and secured

10th position.

Indian Institute of Information Technology & Management in Gwalior scored 69.42 marks and found place in the list of 25 best management institutes in the country.

ITM University (Gwalior) secured 32nd position in top management institute's list.

Unfortunately, no state government run university



in Madhya Pradesh, including Devi Ahilya Vishwavidyalaya in Indore and Jiwaji University in Gwalior, which are Grade A accredited varsities, found place in the list of the top 25 universities in the country.

However, Dr Harisingh Gour Vishwavidyalaya (a central university) in Sagar and Jaypee University of Engineering and Technology in Raghogarh secured

39th and 86th positions, respectively, in the list of the top 100 universities.

Apart from IIT-Indore, School of Engineering & Technology of ITM University (Gwalior) and Pandit Dwarka Prasad Mishra Indian Institute of Information Technology, Design and Manufacturing, Jabalpur secured 58th and 77th positions, respectively, in the list of top 100 engi-

neering colleges.

Shri Govindram Seksaria Institute of Technology and Science (SGSITS), which was ranked as 16th best engineering college by an agency some years ago, and Institute of Engineering and Technology (IET) of DAVV which is considered a leading engineering institute in the state failed to find place in the list of top 100 engineering colleges.

However, SGSITS managed to save its face in the Pharmacy discipline. The institute secured 40th and BR Nahata College of Pharmacy (Mandsaur) got 44th positions, respectively, in the list of top 50 pharmacy institutes.
