IIT-Indore, CSIR-CEERI ink MoU for research

In its endeavour to enhance research, Indian Institute of Technology, Indore has signed a MOU with CSIR-CEERI (Council of Scientific and Industrial Research - Central Electronics Engineering Research Institute), Pilani.

"The MOU has been signed for improving research collaborations between the two institutes, including exchange of scientific staff and students,

joint supervision of Master's and PhD students, exchange of publications and materials, and organisation of research programmes and conferences," a release issued here by IIT-Indore said.

CSIR-CEERI is a premier research institute in the field of electronics.

The MoU was signed during a research workshop at IIT-Indore on September 16, said IIT-Indore media in-charge Nirmala Menon.

She said that IIT-Indore

director Pradeep Mathur and Prof Santanu Chaudhury (director, CSIR-CEERI) inked the MoU.

The focus of talks was to identify areas of mutual interests, and included presentations both from IIT-Indore faculty members as well as a four-member scientific delegation that accompanied Prof Chaudhury.

As a first step, the collaborating groups have been asked to submit proposals for joint research soon.
